# August 10, 2024 OPLC speaker – Karyn Holyk Your Waste is My Treasure! Gemstone Painting

We are in for a super treat at our August 10, 2024, OPLC monthly meeting with **Karyn Holyk**, an Artist, Crystal Alchemist and Teacher, who lives right here in Tucson.

Karyn is a professional watercolor artist. She focuses on making and working with gemstone and crystal pigments as her main medium and creative guide. Yes, she paints with crystals and gemstones! Many she makes herself with verified, ethically sourced crystal and gemstone dusts. Karyn infuses every pigment with clear or rose quartz along with other minerals to amplify their impact and color. Each pigment, like their crystal parent holds a story, lesson and vibration.

Karyn shares that "as a resident of the Southern Arizona's Sonoran Desert, many crystals and gemstones, which become my pigments, are locally sourced. Creative inspiration is literally right under our feet. The magic of my work is the combination of physical properties of each mineral, married with their spiritual and metaphysical attributes". Her artwork and classes weave together a journey through history, faith, color theory, geology, and science. Each piece of artwork and every class is infused with true emotional benefit.

In her presentation and demonstration, Karyn will share her process and technique from taking 50 micron gemstone dust (often the discard) and turning it into stunning pigments. She will make 2-3 beautiful paints and share her fine art techniques. She promises that we'll be inspired by the process and never look at our discarded dust the same way again. "Your Waste is My Treasure!" Her focus in this lecture is on Sonoran Desert Gems, including turquoise, malachite, red Jasper, and black tourmaline.




